Consultation on Admissions Policies for September 2021

The Governing Body of All Saints' Catholic High School is consulting on proposed changes to their admissions policy to take effect for school admissions for September 2021. Specifically, it is proposed to amend criteria 2 and 5 of the oversubscription criteria. The change will mean that children seeking admission under these criteria will be considered to have a sibling at the school at the point of application rather than the point of admission.

This would only have implications for new applications for Year 7 class places from September 2021 onwards and children in other year groups and who have already obtained a place at the school will not experience any changes.
