A **WARM WELCOME** to everyone at Church this week. We also **Welcome** any visitors who may be joining us or their families this weekend.

Cathy Mitchell's Lourdes group arrived safely home early evening last night from Lourdes by Coach, via the towns of Tours and Calais overnight stopovers. Your prayer petitions from Church were taken to the Grotto in Lourdes and you were all remembered in prayer every day. Prayer, Penance, Procession, is part of the story of St Bernadette and Our Lady of Lourdes.

Pilgrimage groups and here back at home too we receive support, grace, God's gifts, particularly in the Sacraments. Part of the love of God is His loving mercy and forgiveness towards us in our need. Penance/Reconciliation/Confession- The confessional here in Church has been tidied and rearranged so that adults can remain unseen by the priest on the other side of the curtain or can choose to walk through the curtain to sit with the priest. Please come and have a look to see the changes inside the confessional room, whether you wish to celebrate confession or not. Just come and see. Whether 'hidden' or 'face-to-face', the sacramental conversation with the priest is private and strictly confidential and remains so outside. This 'seal of confession' gives reassurance and freedom to speak and to experience the lightening of the burdens that we often carry on our shoulders. I will normally be sat in the confessional from the quarter past the hour until the quarter to the hour, before each Sunday Mass. I've fitted a new light outside the confessional, on the glass panel window- if it is green I am inside waiting for anyone to enter and if it is red, someone is already inside making their confession; just sit waiting on any bench outside until the person leaves the confessional and the green light next comes on.

Just a reminder, Church is normally open from 9am 'til 4pm for people to pop in and pay a visit to the Blessed Sacrament for prayers.
